

Three Dimensional Paper Star

I made my Zentangle® inspired stars out of Strathmore coldpress water color paper and used a tiny, ball type burnishing tool to score the creases.

1. Cut out the star.
2. Score lines on the backside of the paper starting at the tip of one of the arms going straight down the middle to the opposite edge of the star. This line is shown on the pattern as a straight line and dotted line. It is best to use a ruler to do this so you have perfectly straight lines.
3. When the scoring is completed, turn the star over and gently fold along the lines with the crease facing you. Where the dotted lines are, you will want to coax the paper to crease away from you.
